

Eyeglass Service Project

Fabric needed:

Lining – flannel, knit, cotton, polyester, jersey (something that won't scratch glass lenses)

Outside - corduroy, duck, quilted, knit, cotton, wool, linen, denim, jersey, velvet

Method #1

Step 1. Cut two different 7-inch square pieces of fabric. One piece used for the outside and one soft or smooth piece for the lining (inside) of eyeglass case.

Step 2. Pin two edges of fabric right sides together and sew a 3/8-inch seam.

Step 3. Understitch seam allowance to lining. This will keep edge from rolling when finished.



Step 4. Fold over at seam inlining top edge. Lining will be longer. Cut off bottom excess.

Step 5. Fold fabric in half with eyeglass case outside together. Pin and sew a 3/8-inch L-shape seam. Trim seam if needed. Trim off corners.

Step 6. Turn right side out. Gently poke out corners. Iron eyeglass case flat. You are finished!



Method #2

How to surge eyeglass cases.

Step 1. Cut one 7-inch square piece of fleece or double sided quilted fabric.

Step 2. Surge top edge. Fold in half continuing to surge side and bottom. Iron eyeglass case flat.

You are finished!
